

Pikes Peak Triathlon Club Presents: Beaver Tail Trail Tri/Du July 6, 2008

General Information.

You must be a current Pikes Peak Triathlon Club member to participate in the Beaver Tri events. \$25.00 individual \$35.00 family. Tri club membership sign up can be made at:

The race is free to members and include after race food/beverage, awards for all participants, lots of prizes/giveaways.

The race entry is limited to a 30-person field.

This is a fun event and can be as challenging as you want it to be. Many participants are seasoned triathletes using this Tri as a training step towards other big races and others are experiencing their first Off-Road fun challenge.

The location/directions to Beaver Tail Trail Tri (Westcreek)

Westcreek is 15 miles north of Woodland Park off Hwy 67 or 7 miles South of Deckers.

Turnoff to venue is between mile marker 91 and 92.

Turn at green hwy sign that says WESTCREEK.

Follow road to bottom of hill. Turn left on Westcreek Rd.

Travel $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to top of hill and turn left into Westcreek Lake Estates. Lake can be seen from road.

Instructions for parking and location of dressing area will be given to all participants prior to race day.

Mandatory pre race meeting 8:30 for maps and special instructions necessary to keep you from getting lost.

Start time 9:00 am prompt.

The swim is a X pattern buoy lake swim approx. 800 yds.

The bike is 14.2-mile combination County rd./creek bed/dual track forest service roads. Several creek crossings and hike-a-bike sections. Hills and sand for your pleasure.

The run is 3+ miles of gravel road and trail. Plan on water crossings.

Duathletes will start the race after last Triathlete exits the water.

3 Forest Service Campgrounds within 15 minutes of venue.
